Monticello Motor Club Paddock Information

Directions from Boston to Downtown Monticello

- Track Address: 67 Cantrell Road, Monticello, NY 12701
- Mass Turnpike (I-90) West to Sturbridge.
- I-84 West through Hartford, Danbury, and Waterbury, CT, into New York State and through Newburgh.
- Exit 4W onto Route 17 West toward Binghamton
- Downtown Monticello is at Exit 106B, Route 42, just south of Route 17
- Follow Rt 42 South through town, taking a left then right to stay on Rt 42.
- Left on Cantrell Road, about 2 miles south of town. Track is on left

Directions to Track from East of Monticello

- Follow Rt 17 West toward Monticello
- Take exit 106 toward County Hwy 172
- Left at the stop, follow signs for Monticello
- Keep left over the bridge over Rt 17
- Sharp left at Rose Valley Rd, just after Mobil station
- Turn right at South Woods Dr.
- Turn left at Cold Spring Rd/County Rt 102
- Turn right at Cantrell Rd.
- Track on the right, 67 Cantrell Rd.

Directions to Track from near Monticello

- Follow Rt 17 West
- Take exit 104
- Slight left toward New York 17B West
- Continue straight onto New York 17B West
- Turn left at Jefferson St
- Turn right at Broadway
- Slight left at Forestburgh Rd/NY-42 South. Continue to follow NY-42 South
- Turn left at Cantrell Rd. Track on the left, 67 Cantrell Rd.

- The track gates are open 7:00am to 7:00 pm

Arrival and Departure

- The track gates are open 7:00am to 7:00 pm
- The access road is only one and a half lanes wide; please do not arrive early.
- Sign the track waiver at the main gate and proceed to the North Paddock (5 on map).
- No at-track overnight camping.
- Trailer Drop-off: Day before trailer drop-off available 5:30pm-7:00pm.
- Guests: Submit any guests who will be arrive separately to the registrar before you depart.
- Depart by 7:00pm to avoid any track overtime charges.

At the Track

- The track opens at 7:00am. The access road is only one and a half lanes wide; please do not arrive early.
- Sign the track waiver at the main gate and proceed to the North Paddock (5 on map).
- Parking: Paved parking is available. Gravel parking is also available for large vehicles. No trailers on pavement.
- Select a parking space and walk to registration inside the facility, straight through the doors. Bring your driver's license.
- Tech inspection will be in the North Paddock Pit Road, starting at 7:15. As soon as your car is prepared (emptied, wheels torqued, tires inflated, numbers on) bring your car, helmet, and tech form to the Tech line.
- Protect asphalt with wood for jacks and jack stands. Clean up fluid spills using your own absorbant.
- Driver's Meeting at 8:30 in main open area in North Paddock. Concurrent Instructors meeting at 8:30 in classroom.
- We will be entering the track using the North Paddock entrance, and exiting the track using both the North and South paddock exits.
- Track entrance and exit blend lines are strictly enforced; do not cross the blend line while entering or exiting the track.
- Incidents may be handled with either a red flag (to stop traffic) or with a black and a yellow flag to return cars to pit road. The wrecker may travel against normal traffic flow. Check your mirrors before slowing and/or stopping.
- The checker flag will be displayed at both the pit road area and on the straight going past the clubhouse. Take the next available exit into the North or South paddock area and proceed back to your parking spot.
- Driver and passenger side windows must be completely down, even if the passenger seat is unoccupied.
- Participant is responsible for track damage, including guard rails and landscaping damage from a significant off track or from negligent damage. Dropping a couple of wheels should not result in a fine from the track.

- Paddock Speed: 10mph. That will feel like walking pace.
- Food may (or may not) be available at the paddock. Burgers are supposedly good, but a bit pricy. Candy and soda is available.
- Fuel available: 93 & 100 octane
- Noise restrictions: 103dB.
- Air: Not available at this time.
- Power: Limited outlets available.
- Fluids: No fluid disposal area. Each individual is responsible for any fluid spills.
- Pet policy: No pets allowed.
- Spectators: Limited area for spectators.
- Vendors: Must contact track prior to event.
- Photography: Outside photographers are permitted. MMC may use any photos taken during the event for website and promotional use.
- Internet access: Wireless available
